1	The driver shows up himself to the guardpost, fills in the access autorization to the site, takes it with him and goes to the expedition/receipt office as soon as he arrives	Respect of 20 km/h. 4	For all loading and all unloading, the driver have to give his keys (and his second key) to Blédina supply person	If the driver don't give his keys, Blédian supply people can refuse to load /unload. 5	If the driver wants to watch the loading/unloading, he stays just next to the following indicator sign (just above)	In warehouses, lift trucks have priority. You have to go slowly and carefully between 2 platforms: I stop at each platform if there is an unload or a load. By no means, the driver have to open doors. Few basics rules (hygiene - environment - behaviour)

Forbidden rules cigarette... piercing... piercing...

It's forbidden to eat, to drink in warehouses except break room. It's forbidden to wear jewellery, watch, piercing.

IN YOUR RESPONSABILITIES AND FOR THE RESPECT OF INFRASTRUCTURES? YOU HAVE TO ALERT US ABOUT ANY ACCIDENT OR DAMAGED (injuries, infrastructure breaked...)

IN CASE OF STOWAWAY IN THE TRUCK, THE BLEDINA PROTOCOL (biovigilance) WILL BE APPLIED: the truck will be stopped, searched, we will check goods...



Behaviour charter:

The driver does not have to disrespect, protest against Blédian people in case of waiting time too long or a late in loading/unloading (the reciprocal is true for Blédina people)

Injured rescue





The witness of the accident is the first link of the rescue chain!

From your reactivity depends the quick arrival of rescue team on the accident area!

You have to:

1 - PROTECT THE VICTIM: Moving the dangerous source aside

2 -ALERT QUICKLY THE INTERNAL RESCUE:

>The SST /Nurse: emergency number 6106

(from outside line: 03 28 42 61 06)

(the guard post will contact the nearest SST)

> The nurse : 6300 (from outside line : 03 28 42 99 60)



<u>Point out</u>: the specific area of the accident, the kind of accident, the number of people concerned, the condition of victim(s)

NEVER hang up in first

If life emergency or if nobody answers to 6106:

Call the 15 (SAMU) wich is in permanent link!

3 - REASSURE: Staying next to the victim until the rescue arrival
