FATALITY/ SERIOUS INJURY PREVENTION – Tata Shotton

An increased number of trailers arriving with sliding roof defects and drivers trying to repair on site by climbing. If this is not stopped immediately this will lead to a serious injury or fatality to a driver.

Most common issues are:

Broken Roof Cords



Roof Jamming



Trailers must be fit for loading before arrival. Roofs must be checked to ensure they are fully operational before arriving on site.

- Drivers must never climb up or try to fix trailers themselves.
- Any driver attempting to fix a roof defect themselves will be banned from all POFM with immediate effect
- Trailers with roof issues will be rejected and drivers will be required to take the trailer and leave the site.
- Drivers will be required to arrange for the trailer to be repaired off site by an authorized repairer.
- Drivers will only be accepted for loading by providing a repair job sheet or certificate provided by the authorized repair company to the site as evidence of authorized repair.

Drivers must contact their Managers to make their own arrangements with their chosen truck repair company. Or alternatively the below company can be contacted:
